Special Agenda Item No.1: Condolence on the sad demise of  
Hakim Ved Prakash Sharma, Member,  
CCIM

It was noted that Hakim Ved Prakash Sharma, member, Unani Committee was expired on 10.11.2007. The Unani Committee observed two minutes silence for the peace of departed soul and pass the following resolution to forward to the members of bereaved family: -

"The members of the Unani Committee were shocked to know the sad and untimely demise of Hakim Ved Prakash Sharma, Member, Unani Committee, devoted his life to the cause of development of Indian Systems of Medicine in general and Unani in particular respectively. Members of the Unani Committee offer their condolence and sympathy to the members of the bereaved family and pray to God that departed soul may rest in eternal peace."

Special Agenda Item No. 2: Election of one member for Executive  
Committee from Unani

It was noted that Hakim Ved Prakash Sharma, Ex-Member, CCIM was a member of the Executive Committee of the Council and due to his death on 10.11.2007, a vacancy has arisen in the Executive Committee to be filled up from amongst the members of Unani Committee.

Agenda Items No. 1: Confirmation of the minutes of 39<sup>th</sup> meeting of Unani Committee held on 16.08.2007 at New Delhi.

It was noted that the minutes of 39<sup>th</sup> meeting of Unani Committee held on 16.08.2007 was placed before the Central Council at its 41<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 18.08.2007 for ratification. The Central Council ratified the same.

Unani Committee confirmed the same.

Agenda Item No. 2: Consideration of visitation report of National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore (Karnataka)

It was noted that the National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore (Karnataka) is proposed to be visited on 13.02.2008 by the following visitors to examine and verify the compliance on the shortcomings pointed out by the Govt. of India for recommendation to the Central Government to issue/not to issue the Letter of Permission to start two new PG Courses in Kulliyat Umoo-e-Tabiya and Ilmus Saidla:-

Unani Committee agreed the same.

Agenda Item No.3: To approve the English Translation of the Syllabus of Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course.

It was noted that in pursuance of decision of the Executive Committee at its 141<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 05.10.2007, the existing Syllabus of Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course is being translated into English by the Central Council by organizing the meetings of experts of the subject concerned. The output of the meeting will be placed before the Committee at the time of consideration of the item.

Unani Committee considered the same and decided that

Additional Agenda Item No. 1: To discuss about the inclusion of some qualifications in the list of Oriental Qualifications approved by the CCIM.

It was noted that a requested has been received from the following Institutions to include their qualifications for the purpose of admission in Pre-Tib Course: -

1. Jamia Darus Salam, Malerkotla(Punjab)
2. Jamia-Tus-Salehat, Rampur(U.P.)

In this connection, it was further noted that Jamia Darus Salam, Malerkotla(Punjab) in its letter dated 30.07.2007 was requested the Council to recognize the Fazil (Urdu, Arabic, Persian, Islamiyat) qualification of the said Institution for the purpose of admission to Pre-Tib Course leading to main BUMS Course and also intimating that the said qualification of this Institution is also recognized by various Universities including Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi and Moulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad as equivalent to 10+2 of these Universities in support of which communications/letters/prospectus of these Universities have been enclosed.

Further, it was noted that in its letter dated 11.08.2007, Jamia-Tus-Salehat, Rampur (U.P) was requested the Council to recognize the Alima and Fazila Courses granted by the said Institution and include the same in the list of Oriental Qualifications approved by CCIM and intimating that the said Alima and Fazila Courses are also recognized by various Universities like A.M.U. Aligarh, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi and Jamia Hamdard, New Delhi.

Vice-President (Unani) was instructed to placed the above two requests before the Education Committee (Unani). Since the meeting of Education Committee (Unani) is not scheduled, therefore, as per instruction of Vice-President (Unani), the above two proposals are placed before the Unani Committee for consideration.

Additional Agenda Item No. 2: Constitutions of Education Committee (Unani) - List of members approved

It is submitted that as recommended by Vice-President(Unani) for the constitution of Education Committee (Unani), the same has been approved by President, CCIM which may be seen at Annex-I.

Additional Agenda Item No. 3: Cut-off marks for admission to Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat(BUMS) Course

It is submitted that as per existing Regulations pertaining to U.G. Course vide IMCC (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulation, 1995, qualification for admission to main Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course has been prescribed as Senior Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Standard)/Intermediate Examination with Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) or its equivalent examination OR Pre-Tib Examination of one year duration. No percentage of marks in the above examinations has been fixed. It is for consideration whether any percentage of marks i.e. cut-off marks is to be fixed for the admission to main Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course.

Additional Agenda Item No. 4: To discuss the issue of continuation of Pre-Tib Course.

It is submitted that as per existing Regulations pertaining to U.G. Course vide IMCC (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulation, 1995, qualification for admission to main Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course has been prescribed as under: -

“Senior Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Standard)/Intermediate Examination passed with Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) or its equivalent”.

OR

“Passed the Pre-Tib Examination of one year duration.”

And qualification for admission to Pre-Tib Course has been prescribed as under: -

“A Candidate seeking admission to one year Pre-Tib Course must have passed the Oriental qualification equivalent to Intermediate Examination, as specified in the list attached to this schedule, recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine leading to main Unani Course.”

Note: - For Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) main Course (Urdu Medium), the candidate should have also passed the qualifying examination with Urdu either MIL examination with Urdu.

In this connection, it may be interpreted that for the admission to main Kamil-e-Tib-o-Jarahat (BUMS) Course, a candidate should have passed either

Senior Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Standard)/Intermediate Examination passed with Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) or its equivalent examination OR have passed the Pre-Tib Examination of one year duration.

In this connection, it is further submitted that in the 48<sup>th</sup> meeting of Education Committee (Unani) held on 30.08.2001 at Agenda Item No. 3, a resolution moved by Dr. M.S. Gupta and seconded by Dr. (Mrs.) Aliya Aman was passed as under: -

“Resolved that provision of one year Pre-Tib Course in the recently proposed Regulation namely IMCC (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999 be deleted.”

The Education Committee considered the resolution and agreed to the same.

The above was ratified by the Unani Committee at its 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 14.03.2002.

Regarding continuation of Pre-Tib Course, a resolution moved by Dr. Saud Ali Khan was also discussed in the Unani Committee at its 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 22.03.2003 but the Committee did not agree.

In this regard, a resolution moved Dr. Saud Ali Khan and seconded by Prof. Abdul Mobin Khan was also discussed in the Unani Committee at its 34<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23.03.2004 and it was resolved that the Pre-Tib Course shall be continued in the Unani Colleges wherever it is applicable.

In this regard, a letter No. R. 12013/3/97 - ISM Tech. dated 22.06.2006 and No. R. 12013/3/97-ISM Tech. dated 11.05.2007 received from the Ministry regarding Council's considered view on Pre-Tib Course may also be seen.
